- How is climate change's effect on hurricanes going to affect the social, economic, and environmental aspects of the Cayman Islands?














Part 1:










CC4. Extreme weather patterns activity



These are the routes of the hurricanes that have hit the Cayman Islands over the past 30 years. What patterns do you see?












CC4. Extreme weather patterns activity
